WHAT WILL WE ACTUALLY DO IN THE WORLD TOMORROW? FEAST OF TABERNACLES 2017 DAY 4 ... 8.10.17

The World Tomorrow will be a world without war ... crime ... drugs ... even "religion". The truth will be available to all of mankind. Who is God? What is man?

What really happened in the past ... before ... and after the Flood? What are the real principles of real living?

It won't just happen. I think we will be quite busy in the World Tomorrow ... teaching people ... to explain ... to help ... our primary role.

<u>Isaiah 11:1-2 (NKJV)</u>

1 There shall come forth a Rod from the stem of Jesse,

And a Branch shall grow out of his roots.

2 The Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him,

The Spirit of wisdom and understanding,

The Spirit of counsel and might,

The Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord.

<u>Isaiah 11:6-9 (NKJV)</u>

6 "The wolf also shall dwell with the lamb,

The leopard shall lie down with the young goat,

The calf and the young lion and the fatling together;

And a little child shall lead them.

7 The cow and the bear shall graze;

Their young ones shall lie down together;

And the lion shall eat straw like the ox.

8 The nursing child shall play by the cobra's hole,

And the weaned child shall put his hand in the viper's den.

9 They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy mountain,

For the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord As the waters cover the sea.

Today ... nobody understands the knowledge of the Lord. The whole earth will be full of the knowledge of God. How will that come about?

Someone is going to have to teach about who God is and what He wants. Someone is going to have to be there to help people unlearn old ways and learn new ways.

The saints are going to be busy helping doing this work.

Malachi 1:11 (NKJV)

11 For from the rising of the sun, even to its going down,

My name shall be great among the Gentiles;

In every place incense shall be offered to My name, And a pure offering;

For My name shall be great among the nations,"
Says the Lord of hosts

Clearly the World to come. His name ... Jehovah God ... will be great among the nations. How? Someone has to provide the teaching. We will be travelling to where the people are ... to do our job.

Isaiah 2:1-4 (NKJV)

1 The word that Isaiah the son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem.

2 Now it shall come to pass in the latter days

That the mountain of the Lord's house

Shall be established on the top of the mountains,

And shall be exalted above the hills;

And all nations shall flow to it.

3 Many people shall come and say.

"Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the Lord,

To the house of the God of Jacob;

He will teach us His ways,

And we shall walk in His paths."

For out of Zion shall go forth the law,

And the word of the Lord from Jerusalem.

4 He shall judge between the nations,

And rebuke many people;

They shall beat their swords into plowshares,

And their spears into pruning hooks;

Nation shall not lift up sword against nation,

Neither shall they learn war anymore.

They won't be learning war anymore ... but they will be learning ... God's ways. The detailed instructions will be down to the saints.

Matthew 28:18-20 (NKJV)

- 18 And <u>Jesus came and spoke to them, saying</u>, "<u>All authority has</u> been given to Me in heaven and on earth.
- 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,
- 20 teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

Go to all nations ... where the people are ... who need the truth ... and teach them. That is the model for the Millennium. Most people won't know about the true God ... and His ways. People will have to be taught how to live.

Matthew 4:1-4 (NKJV)

- 1 Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil.
- 2 And when He had fasted forty days and forty nights, afterward He was hungry.
- 3 Now when the tempter came to Him, he said, "If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread."
- 4 But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.' "

That is true today ... it was true when Moses spoke it ... and will be true in the World to come. Man has to learn every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.

<u>Jeremiah 31:31-34 (NKJV)</u>

- 31 "Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah—
- 32 not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the Lord.

33 But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put My law (Hebrew: Torah) in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people.

34 No more shall every man teach his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the Lord. For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more."

They won't teach each other ... because the saints will have gone out into all nations ... and taught them the truth.

<u>Isaiah 29:9-12 (NKJV)</u>

9 Pause and wonder!

Blind yourselves and be blind!

They are drunk, but not with wine;

They stagger, but not with intoxicating drink.

10 For the Lord has poured out on you

The spirit of deep sleep,

And has closed your eyes, namely, the prophets; (here are people who can't understand)

And He has covered your heads, namely, the seers.

11 The whole vision has become to you like the words of a book that is sealed, which men deliver to one who is literate, saying, "Read this, please."

And he says, "I cannot, for it is sealed."

12 Then the book is delivered to one who is illiterate, saying, "Read this, please."

And he says, "I am not literate."

No one can understand ... but it doesn't stay that way.

Isaiah 29:17-19 (NKJV)

17 Is it not yet a very little while

Till Lebanon shall be turned into a fruitful field,

And the fruitful field be esteemed as a forest?

18 In that day the deaf shall hear the words of the book, And the eyes of the blind shall see out of obscurity and out of darkness.

19 The humble also shall increase their joy in the Lord, And the poor among men shall rejoice in the Holy One of Israel.

That's the big change. People will see and understand ... what the saints teach them.

<u>Isaiah 25:6-8 (NKJV)</u>

6 And in this mountain

The Lord of hosts will make for all people

A feast of choice pieces,

A feast of wines on the lees,

Of fat things full of marrow,

Of well-refined wines on the lees.

7 And He will destroy on this mountain

The surface of the covering cast over all people,

And the veil that is spread over all nations. (Today people can't see the truth because of this spiritual covering ... the Book is sealed ...

but ... these will be taken away)

8 He will swallow up death forever,

And the Lord God will wipe away tears from all faces;

The rebuke of His people

He will take away from all the earth;

For the Lord has spoken.

We will have the ability to teach ... in the right sense.

Isaiah 30:18-21 (NKJV)

18 Therefore the Lord will wait, that He may be gracious to you;

And therefore He will be exalted, that He may have mercy on you.

For the Lord is a God of justice;

Blessed are all those who wait for Him.

19 For the people shall dwell in Zion at Jerusalem;

You shall weep no more. (In the future)

He will be very gracious to you at the sound of your cry;

When He hears it, He will answer you.

20 And though the Lord gives you

The bread of adversity and the water of affliction,

Yet your teachers will not be moved into a corner anymore,

But your eyes shall see your teachers.

21 Your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying,

"This is the way, walk in it,"

Whenever you turn to the right hand

Or whenever you turn to the left.

You will have teachers ... and they won't be taken away and hidden ... they will be there to teach you. Without the teachers ... it wouldn't work.

<u> Isaiah 54:4-8 (NKJV)</u>

4 "Do not fear, for you will not be ashamed;

Neither be disgraced, for you will not be put to shame;

For you will forget the shame of your youth,

And will not remember the reproach of your widowhood anymore.

5 For your Maker is your husband,

The Lord of hosts is His name;

And your Redeemer is the Holy One of Israel;

He is called the God of the whole earth.

6 For the Lord has called you

Like a woman forsaken and grieved in spirit,

Like a youthful wife when you were refused,"

Says your God.

7 "For a mere moment I have forsaken you,

But with great mercies I will gather you.

8 With a little wrath I hid My face from you for a moment;

But with everlasting kindness I will have mercy on you," Says the Lord, your Redeemer.

<u> Isaiah 54:11-14 (NKJV)</u>

11 "O you afflicted one,

Tossed with tempest, and not comforted,

Behold, I will lay your stones with colourful gems,

And lay your foundations with sapphires.

12 I will make your pinnacles of rubies,

Your gates of crystal,

And all your walls of precious stones.

13 All your children shall be taught by the Lord,

And great shall be the peace of your children.

14 In righteousness you shall be established;

You shall be far from oppression, for you shall not fear;

And from terror, for it shall not come near you.

Taught in what manner? Just like in the days of the disciples ... much of the time through individual saints.

He needs to teach us for our future role.

Ezra 7:6 (NKJV)

6 this Ezra came up from Babylon; and he was a skilled scribe in the Law of Moses, which the Lord God of Israel had given.

The king granted him all his request, according to the hand of the Lord his God upon him.

Ezra 7:6 (GNB)

Ezra was a scholar with a thorough knowledge of the Law.

Ezra 7:10

Prepared his heart to seek the law.

Ezra 7:10 (NET)

10 Now Ezra had dedicated himself to the study of the law of the Lord, to its observance, and to teaching its statutes and judgments in Israel.

Ezra prepared his heart ... himself. He didn't just seek the law ... but he did it ... and taught others too.

We could see ourself as "little Ezras" ... dedicated ... students of the Word of God ... having a great attitude. A great example.

<u>Isaiah 66:1-2 (NKJV)</u>

1 Thus says the Lord:

"<u>Heaven is My throne,</u>

And earth is My footstool.

Where is the house that you will build Me?

And where is the place of My rest?

2 For all those things My hand has made,

And all those things exist,"

Says the Lord.

"But on this one will I look:

On him who is poor and of a contrite spirit, And who trembles at My word.

Isaiah 66:2 (HCSB)

2 This is the Lord's declaration.

I will look favourably on this kind of person: one who is humble, submissive in spirit, and trembles at My word.

God's word isn't man's word. God's word is different ... contains wisdom ... understanding ... truth. That is what will have to be taught in the World Tomorrow.

John 6:60-63 (NKJV)

- 60 Therefore many of His disciples, when they heard this, said, "This is a hard saying; who can understand it?"
- 61 When Jesus knew in Himself that His disciples complained about this, He said to them, "Does this offend you?
- 62 What then if you should see the Son of Man ascend where He was before?
- 63 It is the Spirit which gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life.

Jesus' words carry weight ... His words are spirit and life.

John 6:66-68 (NKJV)

- 66 From that time many of His disciples went back and walked with Him no more. (If you walk away from Jesus ... you walk away)
- 67 Then Jesus said to the twelve, "Do you also want to go away?"
- 68 <u>But Simon Peter answered Him</u>, "<u>Lord, to whom shall we go?</u> <u>You have the words of eternal life</u>.

Philippians 2:12-16 (NKJV)

- 12 Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling;
- 13 for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure.
- 14 Do all things without complaining and disputing,
- 15 that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world,
- 16 **holding fast the word of life**, so that I may rejoice in the day of Christ that I have not run in vain or laboured in vain.

HOLDING FAST THE WORD OF LIFE. They will still be words of life in the world to come ... they are words to live by. True values. Everybody needs to know that ... everybody needs to live by that.

2 Timothy 3:13-17 (NKJV)

- 13 But evil men and impostors will grow worse and worse, deceiving and being deceived.
- 14 But you must continue in the things which you have learned and been assured of, knowing from whom you have learned them,
- 15 and that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.
- 16 All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.

Is there any reason why the Holy Scriptures wouldn't be able to help people in the world to come ... any reason that they wouldn't be valuable? They will be applicable in the Millennium.

We should have the same attitude towards the scriptures that Ezra had ... that Paul had ... that Timothy had.

Hebrews 5:11-14 (NKJV)

- 11 of whom we have much to say, and hard to explain, since <u>you have</u> <u>become dull of hearing.</u>
- 12 For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the first principles of the oracles of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid food.
- 13 For everyone who partakes only of milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe.
- 14 But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, that is, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

You and I should be more like Ezra. It's not about gaining knowledge with Biblical factoids! And you get a score of 70% or more ... and go to Heaven.

We should learn it ...live by it ... so that we can teach the whole world ... who is the real God ... and what they need to do to be saved.
